**AWARDS:** \$250 to \$2,000 (number of recipients to be determined)

**ELIGIBILITY:** The recipients of these scholarships must be residents of the

Town of Wilmington, a senior in high school, and must have been accepted to pursue education beyond the secondary school level at an institution deemed accredited by the Scholarship Committee.

#### **CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING WINNERS:**

**A.** Financial need

**B.** Academic standing, including four (4) year transcript

C. Student activity: list all activities, i.e. Class Officer, clubs, yearbook staff, etc.

**D.** Community Service: all involvement in community – volunteer, church service or charity groups, i.e. Boy Scouts, Rainbow, hospital volunteer

**E.** Two letters of recommendation from any of the following:

Any other individual who, in the opinion of the applicant, can testify as to the qualifications of and/or community involvement of the applicant

- **F.** Letter of Intent: An essay, containing approximately 250 words on "What Wilmington Means to Me" shall be submitted with each application
- **G.** Name of the College student will be attending
- **H.** Personal interview may be required
